#### **Chapter 1 Introduction (usually 10-20 pages)**

Context Setting and History of the Issue

Statement of the Problem-usually a paragraph serving as an umbrella statement
Research Questions (Hypotheses)-delineating the specifics of the statement of
problem at the conceptual level (abstract)

Significance of the Study (to the research field and practice)

Definition of Terms for this study-should be cited from a source such as USDE

Delimitation and Limitations-validity and reliability issues both inside the study and to which audience the study results may apply

## Chapter 2 Review of Literature (usually 40-50 pages)

General context literature-arranged either chronologically or by theme

Themes of the research (each section can be drawn from your research questions and the research methodology to be used—this allows some literature to appear in more than one section)

Minimum of 80 sources, 90% of these within the last 7 years Chapter Summary

#### **Chapter Three Research Methods (usually 20-30 pages)**

Qualitative Perspective Used

Research Questions (Hypotheses) in operational form-demonstrates the method and the variables to be used

Researcher's Role-observer, collector, interviewer, etc.

Sources/Subject/Population/Sample-very specific details and citations

Data Collection Methods- very specific details and citations

Data Analysis Methods- very specific details and citations

Validity and Reliability- very specific details and citations

Ethical Considerations- very specific details and citations

### Chapter 4: Findings (usually 15-30 pages)

General introduction

Each research question should have a section with narrative, interview transcription, quantitative results field notes, tables, figures, and graphs when appropriate and required Chapter Summary

# **Chapter 5: Conclusions (usually 20-30 pages)**

Introduction

Statement of Problem

Discussion and conclusions drawn from findings-arrange by research question Implications for Practice *tie these back into your findings and/or literature* Implications' for Further Research *tie these back into your findings and/or literature* Chapter Summary

Each item mentioned under a chapter heading should appear as a subheading in the chapter
